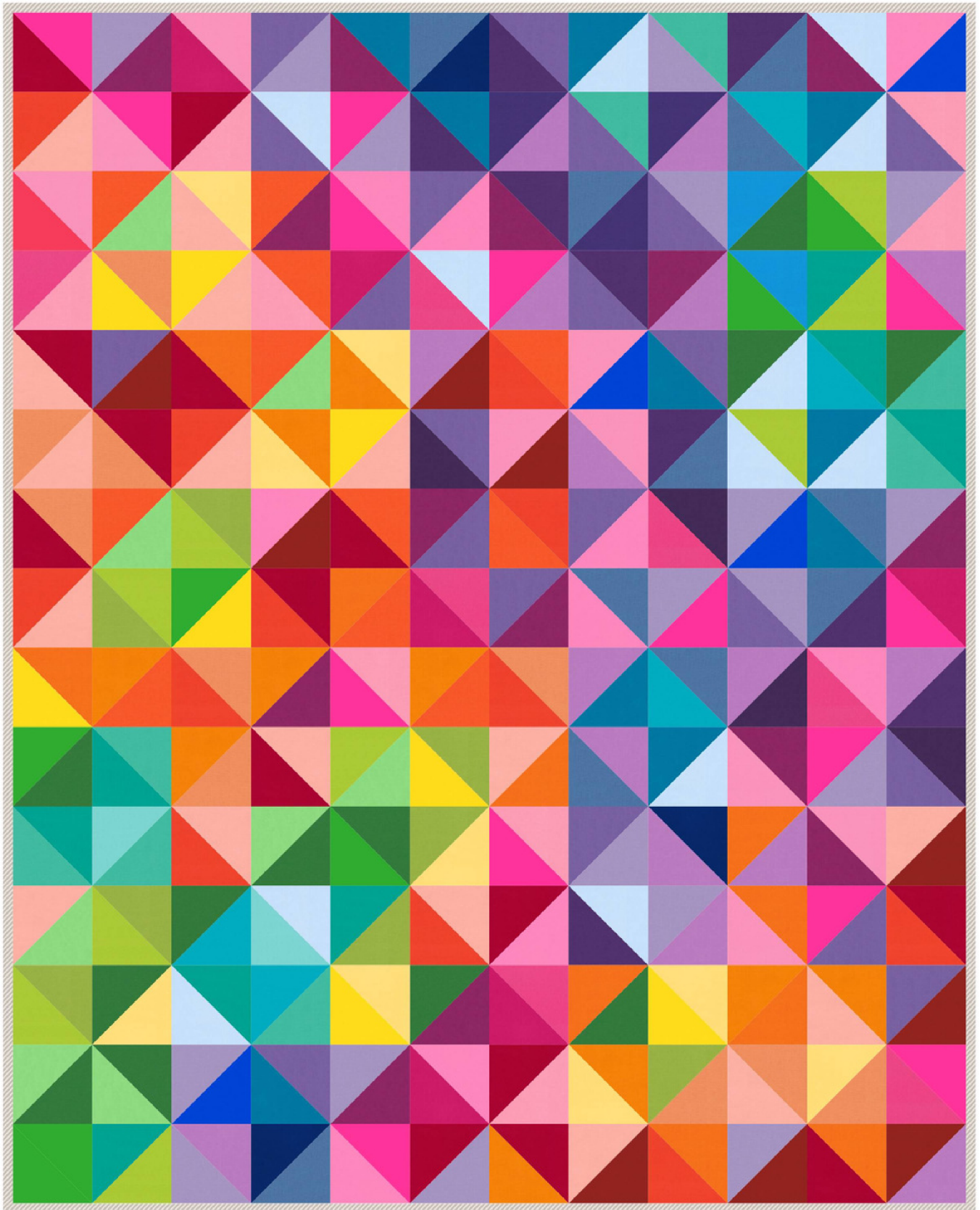


Suggested method of assembly for the

POSTCARDS FROM SWEDEN QUILT



The Postcards from Sweden was a free quilt pattern designed by Kelly Liddle of Jeli Quilts. Unfortunately, the original quilt pattern was hosted on Craftsy/Blueprint for free but is now no longer available.

This is my interpretation of how the quilt can be made.

Postcards from Sweden Quilt

If you want to make an exact replica, you are in luck because Amazon sells a quilt kit with 35 Kona fat quarters and a bit of yardage for the binding for around \$100. (That is actually not a bad deal, as Kona fabric fat quarters can run anywhere from \$3.50 to \$5 per fat quarter. And with the kit, the colors are already curated and put together, so no wasting time searching and adding fabric to an online cart.

Of course, a quilt kit is not necessary. If you want to make the Postcards From Sweden quilt your own, you can use any combination of fabrics. You could use scraps from other projects or a selection of solids.

To make the quilt, you need 180 half-square triangle blocks. (15 rows of 12.) Depending on the size of the squares you start with, you could have different-sized quilts.

As an example:

- 5-inch squares would result in a 48 by 60-inch quilt.
- 6-inch squares equal a 60 by 75-inch quilt.
- 8-inch squares would result in an 84 by 105-inch quilt.

Useful tools:

- Basic sewing/quilting supplies
- rotary cutter and mat
- ruler
- Ruler for trimming half-square triangles
- iron



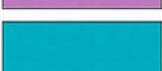
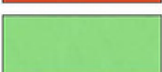

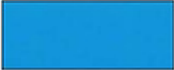
